ELA Priority Standards

AP Howard Thomas briefed us on the lesson study protocol for ELA. He informed us of the importance of understanding the priority of the lesson study. He stated that the priority protocol is when the activity aligns with the learning goals. This should be conducted in a manner where the teacher provides explicit instruction that allows him or her to engage with the students most while students demonstrate learning using evidence.

Math Priority

According to AP Paul, the priority standards ensure that students will have more time to work asynchronous and synchronous. He further stated that one of the goals of The Roberto Clemente School is to raise the level of enthusiasm among students in Math. Some of the ways that this will be done is to include math Olympics, math night, and focus on the learning goals in the lessons (concept development).

Ms. Pascal then asked?: In terms of afterschool programs, will it be done remotely?

AP Paul: It will be done remotely to ensure equity for all students.

Initiatives

Ms. Pascal, our chairperson then continued on the topic of Initiatives. Some initiatives that were discussed are as follows;

- ❖ Principal Cameron also mentioned the importance of the SLT starting an initiative. As a result of the pandemic the SLT will;
 - ★ Engage with students weekly by engaging the students in reading, games, discussions, etc. This will commence the 2nd week of December.
 - ★ Contacting outside organizations
 - ★ Encourage and assist students in developing friendship
 - ★ Create an agreed name for the SLT group (Have students voice in for the group name then come back with a decision on 12/14/20).
